Please remember to NOT put any candy in your child's lunch box. As part of our "Empower Program" with the Health Department we are committed to having our children consume less sugar in their diets.

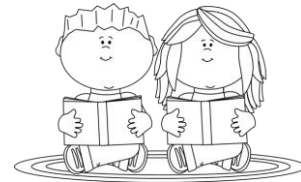
